

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND  
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Hamrun.

Since the plot of land in question is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government in connection with the extension of Victoria Avenue and Villambrosa Street, Hamrun; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £203.2s.6d.

The attached Declaration is intended to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 842, dated 16th December, 1966, in so far as plot 14 therein referred to is concerned.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Hamrun:

Part of the garden of premises No. 102, Villambrosa Street, of the area of 10.40 square canes, including a room measuring 80 square feet, bounded on the South and East by property of Mr. Victor Quintano, on the North partly by property of the Very Reverend Canon Archpriest J.C. Burlo, D.D., and others, and partly by property of Mrs Connie Ashmore, and on the West-South-West by the remaining portion of the garden of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Society of Christian Doctrine.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 253A/66, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration is to supersede that published by Government Notice No. 842, dated 16th December, 1966, in so far as plot 14 is concerned.
