

MEMORANDUM TO CABINET BY THE HON MINISTER OF PUBLIC BUILDING AND WORKS

Erection of a hotel at Point Street c/w Howard Street

Sliema

In October 1967, Messrs Zammit Tabona Bros. applied for the conversion of an existing block of flats in Point Street corner with Howard Street Sliema, into a hotel, and requested also to effect alterations and to construct three additional storeys above the four existing ones.

The application was discussed by the Town Planning Board and the Board agreed that the maximum height of the hotel should be limited to four storeys for **bedrooms** and **two** storeys for services; this in conformity with the policy which was adopted for hotel construction.

Enclosed is a plan showing the height of buildings in the area.

Hon Ministers are requested to consider whether this application should be considered further and permit issued.
