

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of five plots of land at Kirkop.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The plots of land in question are required by the Government in connection with the widening of the approach road to Kirkop Cemetery; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above five plots of land amounts to £882. 18.10d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land:

The following land at Kirkop:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 49.4 square canes, bounded on the South by Saint Nicholas Street, on the East by property of Mr. Wistin Axiag, and on the North by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Rosaria Farrugia as regards the Temporary Utile Dominium and of the Archbishop's Estate as regards the Directum Dominium.
2. A plot of land of the area of 106.9 square canes, bounded on the South by Saint Nicholas Street, on the West by property of Mrs. Rosaria Farrugia, and on the East by property of Mrs. Stella Chircop; it is the property of Mr. Wistin Axiag as regards the Temporary Utile Dominium and of the Archbishop's Estate as regards the Directum Dominium.
3. A plot of land of the area of 19.2 square canes, bounded on the North by St. Nicholas Street, on the East by property of Dr. Vincent Depasquale LL.D., and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Bascal Vella.
4. A plot of land of the area of 89.9 square canes, bounded on the South and South-East by Saint Nicholas Street on the North-East by Government property, and on the West by property of Mr. Wistin Axiag; it is the property of Mrs. Stella Chircop as regards the Temporary Utile Dominium and of the Archbishop's Estate as regards the Directum Dominium.
5. A plot of land of the area of 139.3 square canes, bounded on the North partly by Saint Nicholas Street and partly by Saint Nicholas Cemetery, on the East by War Department property, and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Dr. Vincent Depasquale LL.D.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 288/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
