

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of premises at No. 19, Oratory Street, Cospicua.

Since these premises are required by the Government in connection with a Reconstruction Scheme, they are required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136); owing to the purpose of this acquisition, it is proposed to acquire the above premises by way of public tenure.

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the value of the recognition rent of the premises in question amounts to £50..8..0d. per annum.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.
