

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS.

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of two plots of land at Mersaxlokk.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The land in question is required by the Government in connection with road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above two plots of land amounts to £112.12.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Marsaxlokk:

1. A plot of land of the area of 173.8 square canes, bounded on the West by a public alley, on the East by property of Mrs. Catherine Cauchi and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr. Charles Bartolo Parnis.
2. A plot of land of the area of 28.9 square canes, bounded on the West by property of Mr. Charles Bartolo Parnis, on the South by Government property and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs. Catherine Cauchi.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 256/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
