MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the release of part of a plot of land at "Tal-Hawlija", in the limits of Zabbar.

The plot of land in question had been declared to be required for a public purpose by the competent authority by means of a Declaration signed by His Excellency the Governor and published by Government Notice No.168 of the 6th April, 1948.

As part of the said plot of land is no longer so required, the attached Declaration is intended for its release.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

Whereas by declaration published in the Government Gazette of the 6th April, 1948, under Notice No.168, His Excellency the Governor had declared that a plot of land situated in the lands of "Tal-Hawlija" limits of Zabbar, measuring 1217.1 square cames and bounded on the North-East, partly by Main Street, Zabbar, and partly by the remaining portion of the field of which such plot forms part, on the South-West by waste land belonging to the Government, on the North partly by the property of Gio Batta Zemmit and partly by waste land belonging to the Government and on the North-West by the property of Gio Batta Zammit, was required by the competent authority for a public purpose under possession and use in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Putposrs) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and whereas part of the land is no longer required, I hereby declare for all intents and purposes of law that the undermentioned land which forms part of the land described above is no longer required by the competent authority in accordance with the provisions of the abovementioned Ordinance.

Description of the land

The following land at "Tal-Hawlija" limits of Zabbar:-

A plot of land of the area of 12.6 square canes, bounded on the North-East partly by property of Mr Joseph Grech and partly by property of Mr Emanuele Xuereb, on the West by Labour Road and on the South-East by property of Chevalier Joseph Cassar.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D.179/64, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
