

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.138)

The attached declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land at Zammit Clapp Street, Pieta'.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government for the extension of Saint Luke's Hospital; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 138).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £1,865. 0s. 0d.

The attached declaration is intended to supersede that published by Government Notice No.214 dated the 31st March, 1958.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land in Zammit Clapp Street, Pieta' :-

A plot of land of the area of 84 square metres, bounded on the East by Zammit Clapp Street, on the South by property of the Royal University of Malta, and on the West by Government property, it is the property of Saint Catherine's Monastery of Valletta as regards the directum dominium, and of the heirs of the late Miss Antonia Camilleri as regards the temporary utile dominium.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D.103/69 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 - South Street, Valletta.

This declaration is to supersede that published by Notice No.214 dated 31st March, 1958.
