

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to land at Hamrun.

It is desirable to examine the land described in the aforesaid Declaration with a view to its possible acquisition for a public purpose, namely for a Housing Scheme. This exercise is in accordance with the provisions contained in subsection (1) of section 7 of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136). Such examination is to be carried out with a view to ascertaining whether the land is adapted for acquisition in relation to the above Housing Scheme.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

In accordance with Section 7 (1) of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) I hereby declare that it is desirable that the land described below should be examined with a view to its possible acquisition for a public purpose.

Description of the land

The following land at Hamrun:-

A plot of land of the area of 29 Tumoli, 4 Sieghan and 6.3 Kejllet, bounded on the East partly by property of Mr. Gio Maria Attard and partly by property of Chevalier Alexander Apap Bologna, on the South by a land and on the West partly by property of Mr. Emanuele Falzon, partly by property of Mr. Gio Maria Attard, and partly by property of Mary Orland; it is the property of Chevalier Alexander Apap Bologna.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 110/69. which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
