

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached declaration by His Excellency the Governore-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of six plots of land at Tal-Ibragg, Victoria, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the erection of a Hospital; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £1,312. 0s. 6d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Tal-Ibragg, Victoria, Gozo:

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 tomma and 4.5 kejllet, bounded on the West by Għajn Qatet Street, on the South by property of Mr Francis Portelli, and on the East and South-East by property of Mr Michael Angelo Spiteri.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 siegh and 0.4 kejllet, bounded on the North by property of Mr John Grima, on the South by property of Mr Joe Grech, and on the East-South-East by property of Mr Michael Angelo Spiteri.
3. A plot of land of the area of 1 tomma, 2 sieghan and 5.2 kejllet, bounded on the North and South by property of Mr Mikiel Angelo Spiteri, and on the West partly by property of Mr John Grima, partly by property of Mr Francis Portelli partly by property of Mr Joe Grech and partly by property of Mr Frank Zammit.
4. A plot of land of the area of 1 siegh and 0.4 kejllet, bounded on the North by property of Mr Francis Portelli, on the South by property of Mr Frank Zammit and on the East-South-East by property of Mr Mikiel Angelo Spiteri.
5. A plot of land of the area of 7.7 kejllet, bounded on the North by property of Mr Joe Grech, on the East-South-East by property of Mr Mikiel Angelo Spiteri, and on the West-North-West by property of Mr Frank Zammit.
6. A plot of land of the area of 5.6 kejllet, bounded on the West by Għajn Qatet Street, on the South by property of Mr John Grima, and on the East by property of Mr Mikiel Angelo Spiteri.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 91/68, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
