

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND
PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of twelve plots of land at San Gwann.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for a Housing Scheme; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £30,984. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at San Gwann:

1. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 2 Kejllet, bounded on the East and South by property in course of acquisition by Government, and on the West by property of Colonel Roger Strickland.
2. A plot of land of the area of 3 Tumoli, 4 Sieghan and 2 Kejllet, bounded on the East, partly by property in course of acquisition by Government and partly by property of Mr. George Borg, on the South-East by property of Mrs. Ermelinda Decelis, and on the West by property of Colonel Roger Strickland.
3. A plot of land of the area of 2 Tumoli, 2 Sieghan and 6 Kejllet, bounded on the North-West by property of Colonel Roger Strickland, on the East partly by property in course of acquisition by Government and partly by property of the Franciscan Sisters of Zebbug, and on the West and South-West by property of Mrs. Ermelinda Decelis.
4. A plot of land of the area of 11 Tumoli, 1 Siegh and 6 Kejllet, bounded on the North and North-East by property in course of acquisition by Government, on the East by property of Mrs. Maria Camilleri, on the South-West and West by property of Mrs. Ermelinda Decelis, and on the South by property of the Franciscan Sisters of Zebbug.
5. A plot of land of the area of 4 Sieghan and 6 Kejllet, bounded on the North, North-East and South-East by property of the Franciscan Sisters of Zebbug, and on the South-West by property of Mrs. Ermelinda Decelis.
6. A plot of land of the area of 1 Tomna and 9.8 Kejllet, bounded on the North and North-East by property in course of acquisition by Government, and on the East and South by an alley.

7. A plot of land of the area of 3 Tumoli and 5.7 Kejliet, bounded on the North-west by an alley, on the West by property of Commander David Cox, on the North partly by property of Commander David Cox, and partly by a road, and on the South-East by property of Mr. Joseph Farrugia.

8. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 6 Kejliet, bounded on the East by property of Doctor Louis Galea LL.D., on the South by property of Mr. Joseph Farrugia, on the North-West by property of Mr. Carmel Cauchi, and on the North-East by Government property.

9. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 3 Kejliet, bounded on the East and South by property of Doctor Louis Galea LL.D., and on the North and North-East by Government property.

10. A plot of land of the area of 4 Tumoli, 2 Sieghan and 1 Kejla, bounded on the East, South-East and South by a road, and on the West and North-West by property in course of acquisition by Government.

11. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 9 Kejliet, including a Farmhouse, bounded on the North-East by a road, on the North and North-West by property of Gharghur Parish Church and on the South-East by property of Mrs. Carmela Borg.

12. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sieghan and 3 Kejliet, bounded on the North by Government property, on the East by a road, on the West by property in course of acquisition by Government, and on the South and South-East by property of Captain Charles Pace.

The above mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 199/69, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
