

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Agricultural Leases (Reletting) Act, 1967

The attached draft Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the termination of the lease of two plots of land at Zurrieq.

This agricultural land, which belongs to the Government, is required for a public purpose, namely in connection with a Housing Scheme; consequently the attached Declaration will be signed by His Excellency the Governor-General in accordance with the provisions of subsection (1) of section 20 of the Agricultural Leases (Reletting) Act, 1967.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land owned by Government is required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Agricultural Leases (Reletting) Act, 1967.

Description of the land

The following land at Zurrieg:

1. A plot of land of the area of 5 Tumoli and 8 Kejliet, bounded on the South by a public road, on the North-West by property of the Zurrieg Parish Church, on the North-East partly by a public lane and partly by property of Mr. Saviour Vella.
2. A plot of land of the area of 9 Tumoli, 1 Siegh and 7 Kejliet, bounded on the North by a public road, on the North-West by property administered by the Reverend Monsignor Joseph Farrugia, and on the South-East and South-West by a public road.

The abovementioned two plots of land which make up Rural Tenement 180 in Government Records, are shown on a plan marked L.D. 13/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
