

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET

Part-time Lecturer at the Malta College of Arts,
Science and Technology - Mr P.M. Kozlowski

L-Arkiwi! Nazzjonali ta' Malta

On the 25th May, 1970, Mr Piotr M. Kozlowski, M.B.E., F.R.I.C.S., was granted permission to reside permanently in Malta on condition that he would not engage in any employment whatsoever.

2. The Director of Education with the approval of the Minister of Education, Culture and Tourism is now recommending that Mr Kozlowski be allowed to take up an appointment as part-time lecturer to teach surveying at the Malta College of Arts, Science and Technology, as no suitable qualified Maltese citizen is available.

3. On the 13th March, 1969, it was decided in Cabinet that permanent residents were not to be given work permits even if their services were required by a Government Department. Exceptions to this rule may only be made with Cabinet approval. Ministers are therefore invited to consider whether a licence ought to be issued to Mr Kozlowski to act as lecturer at the Malta College of Arts, Science and Technology, Msida.
