

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of six plots of land at Zejtun.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the formation of a new road connecting 25th November Avenue with St. Catherine Street, Zejtun; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £5,55. 0. 0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Sajtun:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 4 Sighan and 0.6 hejliet, bounded on the South by 25th November Avenue, on the South-west and North-east by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the west and East by property of Miss Molly Curmi and others.
2. A plot of land of the area of 1 Sighan, bounded on the South-west partly by property of Miss Molly Curmi and others and partly by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the North-west and South-East by property of Sajtun Parish Church.
3. A plot of land of the area of 1 Sighan and 5.5 hejliet, bounded on the South-west by property of Sajtun Parish Church, on the North-west by property of Mr. Joseph Gatt and on the west and East by property of Mr. Michael Attard.
4. Part of a field and part of a garden including 4 small rooms, of the area of 3 Sighan and 2.38 hejliet, forming part of premises No. 38, Saint Catherine Street, bounded on the North-west by property of Mr. Angelo Grech, on the west and East by property of Mr. Joseph Gatt and on the South-East by property of Mr. Michael Attard.
5. A plot of land of the area of 3 Sighan and 5.6 hejliet, bounded on the North-west by property of Mr. Angelo Camilleri, on the North by Saint Catherine Street, on the East by property of Mr. Angelo Grech and on the South-East by property of Mr. Joseph Gatt.

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6. A plot of land of the area of 3 Slegnan and 7.4 Kejllet, bounded on the west and south by property of Mr. Angelo Camilleri, on the north by Saint Catherine Street and on the south-east by property of Mr. Angelo Grech.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 285/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 2, South Street, Valletta.
