

REPORT OF THE ENGINEER OF PUBLIC WORKS
AND LAND ACQUISITION OFFICER

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached declaration by his Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of five plots of land at Zebbug, Malta.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the construction of the new Zebbug-Siggiewi Road; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £84. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Zebbug, Malta.

1. A plot of land of the area of 7.9 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West by Zebbug-Siggiewi Road, on the South-South-East by a public road and on the North-East by property of Mr. Salvatore Pace and others.
2. A plot of land of the area of 3 Kejliet, bounded on the South-West, West and South by a public road and on the North-East and East by property of the Zebbug Parish Church.
3. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh and 6.3 Kejliet, bounded on the North and East by a public road and on the South-South-East by property of Mr. James Sammut.
4. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh, bounded on the East by property of Mr. Carmelo Zammit Gauci, on the West-North-West by Government property and on the South by a public road.
5. A plot of land of the area of 4.8 Kejliet, bounded on the North-West and North by property of Mr. Carmelo Zammit Gauci, on the South-West by a public road and on the East by Government property.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 284/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
