

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three plots of land at Mosta.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the erection of a school; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to \$6. 13. 9.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Mosta:-

1. Part of an alley of the area of 0.76 square canes, bounded on the North-West by property of Mr. Nicholas Galea, on the South-East by property of Miss Grazia Debono and others and on the South-West by property of the heirs of Mrs. Regina Debono.
2. Part of an alley of the area of 3.24 square canes, bounded on the North-West by property of the heirs of Mrs. Regina Debono, on the South-East by property of Mr. Nicholas Galea and others and on the South-West by property of Miss Grazia Debono and others.
3. Part of an alley of the area of 8.03 square canes, bounded on the North-West by property of Miss Grazia Debono and others, on the South-East by Wied is-Sir Street and on the South-West by property of Mr. Nicholas Galea and others.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 299/70, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
