

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET

Street Names Committee

TO MINISTERS

The following Memorandum (Minute 35 ex file OPM 2005/48- on Street Names Committee) is being circulated to all Ministers, prior to being discussed in Cabinet.

The recommendations and suggestions are those made by the Prime Minister's Office and do not reflect the views of the Prime Minister. He wishes to have the reactions of Ministers.

"The Street Names Committee, an Advisory Standing Committee, was last reconstituted in 1958 as follows:

Prof. J. Galea, M.B.E., M.D., D.P.H. -
Chairman
Prof. J. Aquilina, B.A., LL.D., Ph.D.(Lond.)
Mr G. Muscat Azzopardi
Mr E. Serracino Inglott
Mr J. Cassar Pullicino
Mr P. Attard, Assistant Secretary, Establishments -
Secretary.

2. Mr Muscat Azzopardi resigned from the Committee when the Colonial Administration took over in 1958, whilst Prof. Aquilina and Mr Serracino Inglott have ceased attending the meetings. The effective strength of the Committee has therefore been reduced to the Chairman and one member.

3. In order that the Committee may discharge its responsibilities more expeditiously, you may wish to consider the request by the Chairman, Street Names Committee for the reconstitution of the Committee and to approve:

i) the retention of the present members of the Committee - namely

Prof. J. Galea - Chairman
Prof. J. Aquilina - Member
Mr E. Serracino Inglott - Member
Mr J. Cassar Pullicino - Member

ii) the inclusion as additional members of the board of Mr G. Muscat Azzopardi and Mr P. Attard (the present Secretary);

- iii) a representative of the Police, the Electoral Office and the Public Works Department to sit as members of the Committee;
 - iv) the appointment of another officer as Secretary who may preferably be on the Staff of Establishments to work in liaison with one of the members namely Mr P. Attard.
4. In Gozo the responsibility of advising Government on street naming devolves on the Gozo Civic Council (L.N. 52/62)".
