

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of parts of three separate premises at Nos. 2, 3 and 6, Alley No. 3, Barracks Street, Qormi.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above parts of premises are required by the Government for the opening of a new street; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above parts of premises amounts to £M 626. 0. 0.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

Description of the land

The following land at Qormi:-

1. Part of premises No. 6, Alley 3, Barracks Street, consisting of 2 rooms, part of a yard, part of an open stairway and part of a garden together measuring 19.23 square metres (84.43 square metres) at ground floor level; and 2 rooms and part of a terrace together measuring 12.4 square metres (54.44 square metres) at first floor level; bounded on the North-East by the said Alley, on the East by Federico Maempel Square and on the West by property of Mr. Gerald Cassar and others.
2. Part of an unnumbered room accessible from a common entrance No. 2, Alley No. 3, Barracks Street, of the area of 5.7 square metres (25 square metres), bounded on the North, East and South by property of Mrs. Giorgina Debono.
3. Part of premises No. 3, Alley No. 3, Barracks Street, consisting of part of a room at ground floor level, of the area of 4.4 square metres (19.32 square metres) and bounded on the North by the said Alley, on the South and East by property of Mrs. Giorgina Debono.

The above-mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 269/71/A, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
