Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

L-Arkiwi! Nazzjonali ta' Malta

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land at Nadur, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government in connection with the widening of San Blas road; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £398. 0. 0.

The plot of land in question has already been taken over and incorporated in the street.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Nadur, Gozo:-

A plot of land of the area of 39.8 square canes, bounded on the North by property of the Basilica of St. George, Victoria, Gozo, on the south and west by San Blas Road and on the east by Mirtle Valley Street.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 261/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
