MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of one plot of land at Victoria, Gozo.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government for the purpose of road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above plot of land amounts to £41. O. Od.
