OPM 502/64. Appointment of Vice-Chancellor of the Royal University of Malta.

Correspondence that passed between H.E. the Governor, the Hon. the Prime Minister and Sir Anthony Inamo on the subjects of the appointments of

Vice-Chancellor of the Royal University of Malta was read to the Cabinet. The Cabinet decided that

a) Professor Marchi's appointment should not be extended beyond the 12th August, 1964;

b) Professor Marchi should be succeeded by Professor E. Roy Costanzi; and

c) An actual appointment of Vice-Chancellor designate should not be made

Reception in Malta of British subjects and friendly nationals from overseas countries.

Mr. E. Cuschieri, Administrative Secretary, and Prof. J. Semana, Attorney General, were in attendance.

The attention of the Cabinet was drawn to an outline plan for the reception in Malta of British subjects and friendly nationals evacuated from Mediterranean countries in an emergency. The plan was circulated to the several departments concerned on the 19th February, 1962. The Cabinet agreed that the arrangements outlined in the plan be put into operation should it be necessary to implement the evacuation scheme for Cyprus.
