Cabinet Meeting held at the Auberge, d'Oragon, Valletta, on Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> February, 1964, at 10.30 am.

The minutes of meetings Nos. 4, 5 and 6/64 were read and confirmed.

Customs duty on a car imported by Mr. P. Caesar Taroggiani (Memo. No. 241).

The Cabinet agreed that Mr. P. Caesar Taroggiani be granted exemption from the payment of Customs duty on a Renault R.8 motor car fitted with automatic gear box and special controls to enable its being driven by a one-armed person.

Deputy Registrars in Her Majesty's Superior Courts (Memo. No. 226).

The Cabinet approved a Bill entitled an Act further to amend the Code of Organization and Civil Procedure Cap. 15, as per draft at Red 106 in file. The object of the Bill was to provide for the clarification of the position of those public officers who performed the duties of Deputy Registrars in Her Majesty's Superior Courts. It specified that those officers were to be designated Deputy Registrars by the Minister of Justice.

Main Ditch, Valletta (Memo. No. 209).

It was agreed that the Military Authorities be asked to see their way to have all structures in Main Ditch, Valletta, removed, especially those which were visible from King's Gate. The Government was also anxious that the road through the Ditch should re-open to the public at an early date.
