Amendment of the Constitution of the Malta Government's Joint Council (Memo. No. 297)  
(Mr. E. Cuschieri, Dr. M. Saffianno + Dr. V. Reyna were in attendance)

It was decided that section 3 of the Constitution of the Malta Government's Joint Council should be deleted and redrafted in such a way as to cover the Cabinet's declared policy of including <sup>(Moviment Agimni Sociali)</sup> the M.A.S. in the Joint Council. It was also decided that other means of standing should be included. The Hon. Minister of Labour + Social Welfare undertook to advise on this matter.

It was agreed that the relative drafts embodying the above decisions be prepared and made available for discussion at the first meeting of the Cabinet when the Hon. Prime Minister returned to Malta.
