Housing Scheme in Australia.

Hon. Ministers considered a proposal for a Housing Scheme for Maltese emigrants in Australia. They were in principle agreeable to the scheme, but left the final decision to the Hon. Prime Minister and the Hon. Minister of Labour & Social Welfare who would first consider the financial implications.
