Textile Industries

The application by Messrs Phoenix
Textile Industries for a Government
subsidy of 7% on about 250 tons of yarn
for export to Europe, which would
involve an expense of between £7,000
and £10,000, was carefully considered.
After having heard the views of the Hon
Minister of Industrial Development and
Tourism it was agreed that Messrs
Phoenix Textile Industries be informed

verbally that their application was being considered and that Government could not furnish them with a decision before a reply is received from the British Government. Hon. Minister of Industrial Development and Commerce was authorized to communicate this decision to Messrs Phoenix Textile Industries.
