Subsidy to Gozitan Milk Producers

✓ Hon. Ministers, after having heard  
the views of the Hon Minister of Agriculture,  
Power and Communications and of the  
Financial Secretary on the proposal to  
grant a subsidy to Gozitan Milk  
Producers on the strength that the cost of  
fodder is dearer than the prices prevailing  
in Malta due to the cost of transport  
between Malta and Gozo, agreed
