L-ARKIVJI NAZZJONALI TA' MALTA

Increase in facilities for movements of tourists between Italy and Malta (Memo. No. 419) (Mr. F. Amato Jurei was in attendance)

Hon. Ministers were agreeable to the proposal to introduce travel facilities between Italy and Malta on a reciprocal basis. These facilities would allow Italian citizens to enter Malta on the strength of a valid identity card, in lieu of a passport, for a stay not exceeding three months. Maltese citizens would similarly be allowed to enter Italy on the strength of a travel document other than a passport for visits of not more than three months duration.
