Hon. Ministers were informed of the estimated costs of taking the dock from the Mediterranean to the Far East (minute 100 in file) It was agreed that Messrs. Christie Maritime Enterprises Ltd. be informed that the Government of Malta would not be prepared to waive the existing Banker's Surety, but would be willing to alter the terms of the agreement entered into with Messrs. S. P. A. Cantieri Navali "Santa Maria" of Genova provided full agreement is reached hereon.
