Free Port Project

(Mr. G. Mallia, Dr. E. Meggi, Mr. A. Booth and Mr. S. Mangin were in attendance)

Hon. Ministers were informed that from representations made by the Malta Industrial Development Study Company Limited it resulted that the whole Free Port project would have to fall through unless the signals installations in the Kalafrana area were removed and a satisfactory solution was found for the financing of such removal.

A letter dated 7th July, 1965, received by the Hon. Minister of Industrial Development & Tourism from the British High Commissioner on the subject ^{was read.} The Hon. Prime Minister undertook to take the matter up again with the British High Commissioner.
