Hon. Ministers agreed to the recommendation made by Establishments, Finance and Education Departments to raise the allowance paid to all Trainees at the Teachers Colleges from £18 to £36 per annum. It was felt that other recommendations, especially those affecting married trainees and trainees eligible for a dependants allowance, merited further study.
