Pensions of Medical Officers and of
Magistrates (Memo. No. 486)

Hon. Ministers again considered the representations made by the Medical Association of Malta for improved pensionability of medical officers in the Government service, in the light of the submissions made on the matter by Finance, Establishments and Seaway study groups. They examined all propositions and agreed that all medical officers in the Government service occupying a pensionable post be granted full pensionability after 30 years service. It was also decided that this concession should be extended to all pensionable employees in the Government service, other than Magistrates whose pension situation was to be studied separately. It was felt that Magistrates should be granted full pensionability after 25 years service.
