Pensions of Medical Officers (Memo. No. 486.
(Mr. E. Cuschieri & Mr. C. J. Dalli were in attendance)

Mr. Cuschieri reported to Cabinet the outcome of a meeting he had just had with representatives of the Medical Association of Malta on the question of pensionability of medical officers in Government service, following the letter which the Association had sent to the Hon. Prime Minister on the 2nd October, 1965. In view of certain fresh submissions of the Association it was decided that the decision

taken in Cabinet on the 28th September, 1965, should not be implemented for the time being, but should be studied and discussed further on the return to Malta of the Hon. Prime Minister.
