Hubbalit Development (Malta) Ltd.

Ministers confirmed their decision taken on 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 1970, that action should be taken to terminate the empythesis granted to Hubbalit Development (Malta) limited.

OPN/67/71

Fishermen's Dwellings at Marsaxlokk.

Ministers reconsidered their decision taken on the 8<sup>th</sup> February 1971, in connection with the assessment of rent for Fishermen's dwellings at Marsaxlokk and decided that the rent payable should be assessed on the current valuation of the Government's architects abated by a third, subject to a minimum rental of £40.

Written Opinion

The following files were circulated to Ministers whose written opinion was as follows:-

OPN/954/70 : Ministers agreed with the proposals in Cabinet Memo N. 1647 namely: that I.L.O. Convention N. 131 could be ratified after further studies and that I.L.O. Convention N. 132 could not be ratified at this stage and that Recommendations 135 and 136 could be accepted as useful guidelines for future development in the fields they cover.
