The Minister of Trade, Industry and Agriculture informed Cabinet that Camana Cold Stores at Barrera is no longer in operation. Ministers decided to ask the Principal Assistant Secretary (Administration) to enquire whether excess cold storage facilities are available in Service Establishments to provide cold storage for fish.

Civil Abattoir

The Minister of Trade, Industry and Agriculture read a letter minute by the Director of Public Works recommending that call for tenders for the Civil Abattoir should not be limited to the Slaughter Hall~~s~~ but should be extended to the whole of Phase I at a capital cost of £600,000 instead of £300,000 provided in the Third Five Year Plan. Ministers decided to ask the views of Finance and Economic Planning before a decision is taken.


