

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET

Permission to Messrs. Shell Co. (Malta) Ltd.
to operate a Bonded Store at their
Grand Harbour Installation

Section 27(1) of the Customs Ordinance (Cap. 60) states that, independently of any other law, it shall be lawful for the Governor to approve or appoint warehouses or places of security within these Islands for the warehousing of dutiable goods without payment of duty on the first entry thereof.

2. The Shell Co. (Malta) Ltd. have applied to have the premises occupied by them and situated at the Grand Harbour Installation, Spencer Glacis, Marsa, declared a bonded warehouse in terms of the abovequoted section of the Customs Ordinance, for the warehousing of marine lubricants on first entry. The premises have had alterations carried out to them to afford adequate security, as recommended by the Customs Department, and they are now considered to be safe and secure for the storage of uncustomed goods.

3. Hon. Ministers are asked whether they agree that the Governor be advised to sign an Order authorising the appointment of the Shell Co. (Malta) Ltd.'s Grand Harbour Installation at Spencer Glacis, Marsa, as a bonded warehouse for the purposes of the law.
