In terms of Section 52(2) of the National Insurance Act a copy of Actuarial Reports asked for by the Minister shall be laid on the Table of the Legislative Assembly.

The first quinquennial Actuarial Report on the operation of the National Insurance Act was received in November, 1961 when there was no Legislative Assembly in existence and the Report remained unpublished.

In accordance with your instructions I have sought Crown Counsel's advice on the matter and his feeling is that once the Report was not published in the Government Gazette at the time it was received it should now be laid on the Table of the Legislative Assembly in order to comply with the provisions of the Law. No time limit is specified in the Law and it would therefore be in order to make it public now.
