Exemption from Customs Duty
Lt. Cmdr. J. Ashforth

Lt. Cmdr. James Ashforth, R.N. lost his family's personal effects when the s/s "Clan Keith" sank in the Mediterranean on its way to Malta in November, 1961.

2. Other members of the Crew of the ship in question were given exemption from customs duty on replacements of the lost possessions. Cmdr. Ashforth's application is being recommended now because the sworn affidavit covering his losses was only submitted recently.

3. In the circumstances Hon. Ministers are asked whether they agree that His Excellency be advised to authorize the exemption from duty applied for by Lt. Cmdr. James Ashforth and to sign the enclosed Exemption Order.
