

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET
BY THE ACTING MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL
DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM

Exemption from duty on a car imported
by Mr Joseph Cassar

Section 13 of the Import and Export Duties Ordinance (Cap. 122) lays down that it shall be lawful for the Governor to admit the importation into these Islands of any goods, free from all duties of Customs whatsoever.

2. An application has been received from Mr Joseph Cassar of 70, Our Lady of Angels Street, Zebbug, who is a paraplegic, requesting exemption from duty on a Junior Auto Union D.K.W. motor-car with Automatic Saxomat device which he is importing for his sole use.

3. After careful consideration of Mr Cassar's application, the Minister of Industrial Development and Tourism considers that applicant's request should be approved.

4. Hon. Ministers are asked whether they agree that His Excellency be advised to authorize the importation of Mr Joseph Cassar's car free of Customs duty and to sign the enclosed Exemption Order.
