

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET

Declaration of premises at No. 86,
Jetties Wharf, Marsa, as a bonded store

Section 27(1) of the Customs Ordinance (Cap. 60) states that, independently of any other law, it shall be lawful for the Governor to approve or appoint warehouses or places of security within these Islands for the warehousing of dutiable goods without payment of duty on the first entry thereof.

2. Mr E. Cassar of No. 8, Gunlayer Square, Floriana, who has purchased a crane from a Service sale with a view to its exportation, has requested permission to operate a bonded store at No. 86, Jetties Wharf, Marsa, for the purpose of temporarily storing his crane therein.

3. The Comptroller of Customs reports that the store is safe and secure for the purpose intended, and that Mr Cassar has produced a Bank guarantee to the amount of £160 to cover the duty involved. The Hon. Minister of Industrial Development & Tourism (ad int.) recommended the request.

4. Hon. Ministers are, therefore, asked to say whether they agree that the Governor be advised to sign the enclosed Order authorising the appointment of the premises at No. 86, Jetties Wharf, Marsa, as a bonded warehouse.
