

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET  
BY THE HON. THE PRIME MINISTER

Issue of Restricted Certificate of Competence in Radiotelegraphy to Mr Dennis Andrew Gillings

Under rule 3 of the Wireless Telegraphy (Certificate of Operators) Rules, 1959, made in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Wireless Telegraphy Ordinance, (Cap. 78), a radio operator may obtain any of the following certificates:

- (a) First Class Certificate of Competence in Radiotelegraphy;
- (b) Second Class Certificate of Competence in Radiotelegraphy;
- (c) Special Certificate of Competence in Radiotelegraphy;
- (d) General Certificate of Competence in Radiotelegraphy; and
- (e) Restricted Certificate of Competence in Radiotelegraphy.

2. Examinations for any of the above certificates are conducted by the Government Inspector of Wireless Telegraphy in accordance with the requirements of the Radio Regulations annexed to the International Telecommunications Convention, Geneva, 1959.

3. Mr Dennis Andrew Gillings has passed the necessary examination for a Restricted Certificate of Competence and it is therefore proposed to issue to him the necessary certificate and authority to operate granted by the Governor.

4. Hon. Ministers are kindly asked whether they agree that:

- (a) His Excellency be advised to sign the Restricted Certificate of Competence in Radiotelegraphy to be issued to Mr Dennis Andrew Gillings; and
- (b) in future, in view of the routine nature of such matters, the Hon. Prime Minister should have the general authority of the Cabinet to advise His Excellency in connection with the issue of such certificates without the necessity of consulting the whole Cabinet.
