

MEMO for the CABINET by the Minister of Justice
Release of land in New Street, Luqa

The land in question was earmarked for public acquisition in terms of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance, Chapter 136. The site was required for the purposes of constructing a playground in the Luqa area.

By Government Notice No.363 of the 26th May, 1958 the land in question was declared to be required by the competent authority in terms of the law.

It has now emerged that the site under review is no longer required by the Government, and a Declaration has been drawn up with a view to declaring in terms of the aforementioned ordinance that the land in question is no longer required by the competent authority. Hon. Members are asked to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR

Whereas by a declaration dated the 26th May, 1958, published in the Government Gazette of the 9th June, 1958 (Government Notice No. 363 of 1958), His Excellency the Governor declared the undermentioned land to be required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and whereas such land is no longer so required, I hereby declare for all intents and purposes of the law that the undermentioned land is no longer required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the aforementioned Ordinance.

Description of the Land

The temporary utile dominium of the plot of land in New Street, Luqa of the area of 3 sieghan and 5 kejllet of agricultural land and 330 square canes of building site which includes the area occupied by room A. This plot forms part of Government Tenement No. 81 "Madalena". It is bounded on the South-west by New Street, on the North-north-west partly by the property of Albert Vassallo A.& C.E. and partly by the property of Salvino Cachia and on the East-north-east by the property of Andrew and John Scicluna. It is held on long lease expiring on the 15th August, 1983 by Giuseppina Debono.
