

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET

Public Holiday on 7th January, 1963

The feast of the Epiphany (6th January, 1963) - one of the annual paid public holidays - falls next year on a Sunday.

2. In accordance with approved practice, it is suggested that it may be recommended to His Excellency the Governor that Monday, 7th January, 1963, may be declared a public holiday under section 3 of the Public Holidays Ordinance (Chap. 55).
