

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136)

The attached Governor's Declaration proposes to acquire by absolute purchase in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136). Some private property surrounding St. John's Cavalier, part of which is to be turned into a car park.

The acquisition is for a public purpose in terms of the law.

Hon. Members are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following premises at Valletta:-

1. Premises No. 2, Old Bakery Street, now demolished, property of the Friars Minors Conventuals of St. Francis Priory of Valletta.
2. Premises Nos. 6 and 6D, Cavalier Street, now demolished, property of the Government of Malta as regards the Directum Dominium and of Miss Lucrezia Vella as regards the Temporary Utile Dominium.
3. Premises Nos. 166/167/168, Old Mint Street, now demolished, property of Chev. Dr. Joseph A. Reynaud LL.D.

The above mentioned premises are shown on plan marked L.D. 112/63 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
