

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE

LAND ACQUISITION (PUBLIC PURPOSES) ORDINANCE CAP. 136

The Declaration attached to this Memorandum supersedes the former Declaration in connection with the acquisition of a site in the limits of Birkirkara inherent to the extension of a factory. The matter has already been discussed in Cabinet.

The acquisition is for a public purpose in terms of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and it is to be effected by absolute purchase.

The proposed Declaration adjusts the property bounding the site to be acquired and the plan edged in red and green specifies the details of the proposed extensions of the factory. It has been ascertained that the plot of land in question is at Birkirkara and not at Msierah.

Hon. Members are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Birkirkara:

1. A plot of land of the area of 6 Tumoli 4 Sieghan and 2 Kejllet, bounded on the North partly by property of Rev. Can. V. Saliba and partly by property of the Balzan Parish Church, on the West partly by property of Miss Catherine Sciberras and partly by property of Mr John Azzopardi, on the East partly by property of the Church of St Paul's Shipwreck of Valletta and partly by property of Miss Rosanna Pace, both in course of acquisition by Government and on the South by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Birkirkara Parish Church.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 136/63 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
