

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CABINET

BY THE HON. PRIME MINISTER

Air Navigation (Fees) Regulations, 1964

The Thirteenth Schedule to the Colonial Air Navigation Order 1961 lays down the fees that may be charged for work associated with the registration, certification and maintenance of aircraft and for the issue of crew licences etc. Article 73(3) of the Order provides that the Governor may by regulation substitute different fees from those prescribed. New Air Navigation Regulations were made by the Ministry of Aviation in the United Kingdom on 2nd May, 1962, and it is proposed to publish Fees Regulations in Malta to raise our charges and bring them on a par with those currently obtaining in the United Kingdom.

2. A draft of the Regulations has been prepared and examined by the Attorney General's Office (Red 3 in file).

3. Hon. Ministers are asked whether they agree that His Excellency the Governor be advised to make the Air Navigation (Fees) Regulations, 1964.
