Drawback on Cars sold to Refined Personnel

Personnel attached to Headquarters, Allied Forces Mediterranean, are allowed to import a motor car duty-free for their own use.

2. In order to induce such personnel to buy locally assembled cars instead of imported ones it is proposed to issue the attached drawback order under section 17A of the Import and Export Duties Ordinance. The order provides for the refund of the import duties paid when the component parts were imported into Malta.

3. The Order has of course been vetted by the Attorney General's Office as usual.

4. Hon. Ministers are invited to advise His Excellency the Governor to make the attached Order.

IMPORT AND EXPORT DUTIES ORDINANCE  
(CLP. 122)

Import Duties (Locally Assembled Cars Supplied to Personnel attached to Headquarters, Allied Forces Mediterranean) Drawback Regulations, 1964.

Date of Commencement:

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 17A of the Import and Export Duties Ordinance, the Governor has made the following regulations:-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Import Duties (Locally Assembled Cars Supplied to Personnel attached to Headquarters, Allied Forces Mediterranean) Drawback Regulations, 1964.

Citation

2. Subject to the provisions of the Import and Export Duties Ordinance and of article 3 hereof, a drawback of the import duties charged on the completely knocked down parts, materials and accessories incorporated in locally assembled cars shall be allowed when such cars are supplied directly to personnel attached to Headquarters, Allied Forces Mediterranean.

Drawback on locally assembled cars supplied to personnel attached to Headquarters, Allied Forces Mediterranean

3.(1) A claim for the payment of such drawback shall be supported by a certificate issued by the Headquarters Commandant, at Headquarters Allied Forces Mediterranean showing that cars assembled in these Islands in respect of which drawback is claimed have been supplied to personnel attached to Headquarters, Allied Forces Mediterranean.

Evidence of the supply of locally assembled cars to personnel attached to Headquarters, Allied Forces Mediterranean

(2) For the purposes of the payment of drawback under these regulations a certificate issued in accordance with paragraph (1) of this regulation shall be sufficient evidence of the facts stated therein unless the contrary is proved.
