

MEMORANDUM FOR CABINET BY THE MINISTER OF
INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM

Customs duty on a car imported by Mr P. Cassar Torreggiani

Mr Peter Cassar Torreggiani has applied for exemption from payment of Customs duty on a Renault R 8 motor car fitted with an automatic gear box and special controls to enable its being driven by a one-armed person.

2. The applicant was the victim of an accident which necessitated the amputation of his right arm. He has produced a certificate by the Senior Health Officer to the effect that he is able to drive a car fitted with special controls.

3. The duty on the car which it is proposed to import is estimated to amount to £270.

4. It has so far been the policy to grant similar requests, on compassionate grounds, and Hon. Ministers are invited to agree that His Excellency the Governor should sign an Exemption Order in this case, under section 13 of the Import and Export Duties Ordinance (Cap. 122).
