

Memorandum by the Minister of Justice  
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance  
(Chapter 136)

It is proposed to acquire four plots of land at Gharb, Gozo, required for the erection of a primary school.

The acquisition is for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and title of acquisition is to be by way of absolute purchase.

Originally more land had been earmarked for acquisition as it emerges from two previous declarations published respectively in the Government Gazette by Notices No. 688 of 11.12.58 and No. 198 of 3.4.59. This explains why it is indicated that this declaration is to supersede the previous declarations published in 1958 and in 1959.

From the valuation report by the Land Engineer for the four plots under review it emerges that the value has been assessed at £298.6.4. Obviously this valuation report supersedes the two former valuation reports by the Land Acquisition Engineer.

Hon. Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following four plots of land at Gharb, Gozo:

1. A plot of land of the area of 2 tmien and 2.7 kejljet, including a room, bounded on the South-south east by property of the Government of Malta, on the East-north-east partly by property of Mr Joseph Custo' and partly by property of the heirs of Rev. Can. Vincent Portelli and on the North-north-west partly by property of Mr Salvu Portelli and partly by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Joseph Portelli.

2. A plot of land of the area of 3.88 kejljet bounded on the South-south-east, on the East-north-east and on the West-south-west by property of Mr Joseph Portelli and on the North-north-west by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Salvu Portelli.

3. A plot of land of the area of 1.3 kejljet, bounded on the South-south-east by property of Mr Joseph Custo', on the West-south-west by property of Mr Joseph Portelli and on the North-north-west and on the East-north-east by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the heirs of Rev. Can. Vincent Portelli.

4. A plot of land of the area of 7.6 kejljet, bounded on the West-south-west by property of Mr Joseph Portelli, on the South-south-east by property of the Government of Malta, and on the East-north-east by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mr Joseph Custo'.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 124/63 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.

This declaration supersedes those published by Government Notices No. 688 of the 11th December, 1958 and No. 198 of the 3rd April, 1959: the plots or parts of plots comprised in the latter declarations and which are not included in the present declaration are no longer required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the aforementioned Ordinance.
