

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance  
(Chapter 136)

The attached Declaration covers two plots of land at Bir-id-Deheb in the limits of Zejtun. The land is to be acquired by absolute purchase and it is required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) in connection with the road widening of Bir-id-Deheb Road.

It emerges from the valuation report of the Land Engineer that the freehold value of the two plots would amount to £160. 1s. 8d.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Bir-id-Deheb, limits of Zejtun.

1. A plot of land of the area of 3.3 square canes, bounded on the North-West and on the West by Tal-Barrani Road, on the South by property of Mrs Carmela Zammit and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs Vincenza Zammit.

2. A plot of land of the area of 8.0 square canes, bounded on the North by property of Mrs Vincenza Zammit, on the South and on the West by Tal-Barrani Road and on the East by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of Mrs Carmela Zammit.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 29/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
