

Memorandum by the Minister of Justice
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance
(Chapter 136)

Attached Declaration refers to a plot of land at Buskett in the limits of Siggiewi. The site in question which is rather extensive is described as wasteland.

It appears that parking facilities around the Boschetto leave much to be desired and the Commissioner of Police pointed out that owing to lack of parking space several motorists, to their disappointment are ordered to turn back from the Boschetto neighbourhood during the Imnarja Festivities.

The land is required for the formation of a car-park and it is therefore being acquired for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136). The site is to be acquired by title of absolute purchase.

Hon. Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Buskett in the limits of Siggiewi.

A plot of land at Ghar-il-Kbir and Misrah Ghar-il-Kbir of the area of 56 Tmien, 2 Sieghan and 5 Kejllet, bounded on the North by the road connecting Buskett and Ghirghenti, on the South by property of Mr. J. Laferla and others, on the East by property of Miss Maria Zammit Gauci and others, and on the West by property of Mr. A. Camilleri and others: this land is held on temporary emphyteusis from Government by Mrs. Giuseppa Fenech and others.

The above mentioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 63/64 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
