

MEMORANDUM FOR CABINET BY THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL
DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM

Car imported by Miss Mary Scicluna

A request has been received from the Hon. Secretary of the Infantile Paralysis Rehabilitation Fund for the waiving of customs duty on a Hillman Imp motor car, fitted with Reselco Conversion, which is being imported by Miss Mary Scicluna of 23, St. Mary's Street, Gudja, who is a paraplegic. A medical certificate attesting to her condition and that she is able to drive a car fitted with Reselco Conversion has been produced.

2. The value of the car is stated to be about £442 and the duty involved amounts to £175.

3. Similar requests have been approved in the past, and Hon. Ministers are invited to agree that exemption from duty be granted in this case too. The Governor would then be asked to sign an Exemption Order under section 13 of the Import and Export Duties Ordinance (Cap. 122).
